In September 2009, Global Television aired Rick Green's documentary about Adult Attention Deficit Disorder (also known as ADD or ADHD), entitled, **ADD & Loving It?!** Winner of the World Silver Medal for best medical documentary at the 2009 New York Festivals, the film follows the story of Canadian actor Patrick McKenna as he gets a formal diagnosis and decides to educate himself about what ADHD is, and isn't. It is a groundbreaking exploration of Adult Attention Deficit Disorder. Praised by medical experts and people with ADD, this imaginative documentary uses comedy and facts to de-stigmatize this disorder, through Patrick's personal story and 9 of North America's top ADHD experts. Rick was awarded the CAMH (Centre for Addiction and Mental Health) Foundation's 2009 Celebrity Transforming Lives Award - before **ADD & Loving It?!** had even aired. The nomination stated, "In one hour this program will transform how Canadians view this disorder." Transforming people's view of ADHD and providing good information is also the motivation behind TotallyADD.com which Rick launched in December 2009. TotallyADD.com is a resource and community for anyone affected by Adult Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder.
